Application Requirements:

An applicant for admission to the Alabama Banking School must meet one of the following criteria: (I) be an officer, director or an employee of a commercial bank or other approved financial institution; (II) a staff member of the Alabama State Banking Department, Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, Federal Reserve Bank or Office of the Comptroller of the Currency; or (III) an officer or employee of an associate member of the Alabama Bankers Association. **Employees of non-member banks may attend at an additional fee per year.**

Applicants must be high school graduates and must have had two years of banking experience prior to the opening date of School. Two years or more of college education or a diploma from the American Institute of Banking may be substituted for one year of banking experience. Familiarity with basic accounting is highly desirable.

Application Agreement:

In completing this application to the Alabama Banking School, I acknowledge that I will attend all scheduled classes and all school-sponsored activities during the School session, successfully complete all assigned home study problems, and abide by all the rules and regulations of the School. Failure to do so will cause loss of credit and/or dismissal from the School. My grades may be made available to senior management upon written request.

I understand and agree that I will be required to live in assigned lodging.
